

Municipal Board of Canvas – April 4, 2023

Posted Tuesday, March 13, 2023 at the Town Garage and the Town web site.

This meeting was to certify the successful winners of the Town of Russell chairman and two supervisor positions to complete the Spring Election held April 4, 2023.

The meeting was called to order at 8:40 p.m. by Chief Election Inspector Dianne Nelson. Roll call of attendance was as follows; Election Inspectors Kay Deragon, Rebecca Benton, Judy Boutin, Cindy Garrity, Lynda Good, and Carol Newago were present as well as Clerk/Treasurer David L. Good.

The final tally of voters was 296 and the election results recorded appropriately. There were no provisional ballots.

The Certification of the contest winners for the Town of Russell Board of Supervisors was completed. Three positions were open to be filled. The tabulated votes for Town Chairman were announced. The MBC confirmed by vote that the highest vote getter for Chairman was Paul “Rocky” Tribovich. The tabulated votes for the two Town Supervisor positions were announced. The MBC confirmed by vote that the highest vote getters for two Supervisors were Larry Meierotto and Don Sullivan.

All reports, forms, and documents to finalize the election were completed and signed.

Chief Inspector Dianne Nelson called the results of the Municipal Board of Canvas to the Bayfield County and School District of Bayfield Clerks. The results of this election follows on the official minutes of the Town of Russell.

The Board of Canvas was adjourned at 8:43 p.m.
